

Docker Product Schedule

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“Agentic Platform API” and **“Agentic Platform SDK”** means Docker-provided application programming interfaces and software development kits for interacting with the Agentic Platform Services.

“Cloud Sandbox” means a Docker-provided, ephemeral runtime environment within Agentic Platform that executes Customer’s workloads.

“Docker Build Cloud” means the hosted cloud service for building container images.

“Docker Desktop” means the downloadable object-code of the desktop client software component of the Service.

“Docker Hardened Images” and **“DHI”** mean a catalog of security-enhanced Docker Images.

“Docker Repo Unit” means an individual repository of the Docker Hardened Images catalog.

“Docker Hub” means the hosted repository component of the Services for finding and sharing container images.

“Docker Images” means an executable Docker software package for running one or more software applications published by Docker.

“Docker Plan” means the Services licensed by Customer under the corresponding Order Form.

“Docker Offload” means a cloud-compute service that enables the Customer to run containerized workloads in Docker-operated cloud environments from Docker Desktop or the Docker CLI.

“Docker Scout” means a component of the Services used for providing insights and suggestions on improving software supply chain including aspects of security and vulnerability scanning.

“ELS Catalog” means the repositories for which Docker offers Extended Lifecycle Support (“ELS”), as identified in Docker’s documentation and updated periodically.

“ELS Repo Unit” means an individual repository of the Docker Hardened Images catalog subject to Extended Lifecycle Support.

“End-of-Life (EOL)” means the date the originating open-source project ceases to provide security or maintenance updates.

“Docker Gordon” or **“Gordon”** means Docker’s AI-powered assistant which helps developers automate and optimize container workflows upon appropriate User control.

“Local Sandbox” means the placement of a Sandbox on the Customer’s local machine.

“MCP Gateway” means a cloud-based proxy that routes to multiple MCP servers and manages credentials for each connection.

“Pay-As-You-Go Products” means the product or service listed on the applicable order form payable on a pay as you go basis (“Pay-As-You-Go”) pursuant to the corresponding consumption resources rate card.

“Testcontainers Cloud” means the hosted cloud service of the Services for provisioning disposable, on-demand virtual containers for software development and testing use cases.

“Consuming Domain” means the domain of an organization identified by Docker as pulling Customer’s images by accessing Customer’s repository on Docker Hub, provided that the organization’s users are authenticated on Docker Hub. Docker will not disclose any personal data of such users.
